Edinburgh Airport is Scotland's capital airport, with a worldwide reputation and worldwide connections.

Over 40 airlines serve over 100 destinations, and over nine million business and leisure passengers pass through the airport a year making Edinburgh Scotland's busiest airport. Passenger numbers are set to grow as the airport develops new international connections to Germany, Sweden and Spain.

The most popular destinations are in Spain, although Paris, Amsterdam, Belfast and Dublin are also long standing favourites. New York is the most popular long-haul destination,

and the top domestic destinations include Birmingham, Belfast, Manchester and the London airports.

Edinburgh Airport is situated to the north west of the city, just off the A8 and is approximately 20 minutes by car from the city centre. If using a satellite navigation system the postcode is EH12 9DN. There are three public car-parking areas at the airport offering a total of approximately 6,400 spaces. There is also a passenger drop-off in the forecourt area.

Airport Links

The nearest rail stations are Edinburgh Waverley, Haymarket and Inverkeithing.

Edinburgh Shuttle is a door-to-door service between Edinburgh Airport and anywhere within a specified City Centre zone. The fleet of seven-seater mini coaches runs daily every 15-30 minutes.
