Ebbsfleet International

Situated between Dartford and Gravesend, the high-tech Ebbsfleet International opens up major travel opportunities for people living across the South East. The station currently offers Eurostar services but will also provide four platforms for new high-speed domestic journeys in 2009 on HS1.

Facilities at Ebbsfleet International

- Eurostar ticket office (open daily from 5.00am – 22.30), group welcome desk, special assistance desk and self-service ticket collection machines

Getting to Ebbsfleet International

By Fastrack: Ebbsfleet International is connected directly to Dartford, Gravesend, Greenhithe, Bluewater and Swanscombe by Fastrack. See page 16.

By train: From London, change at Greenhithe and connect with Fastrack B. Towards London, change at Gravesend, exit platform 2 and cross road to Fastrack B stop. Southeastern trains' services will connect in 2009 when its new high-speed services become available to domestic commuters.

By car: Minutes from Junction 2 of the M25 and also close to the A2, M2 and M20, the station offers 'park-and-ride' facilities for up to 5,000 vehicles.

By coach: National Express Coaches stop at Ebbsfleet on the Dover-Canterbury-London Victoria route.

The station is one of first tangible pieces of infrastructure in one of the UK's most ambitious and large-scale regeneration and development projects – Ebbsfleet Valley.
