The developer behind Wirral Waters is The Peel Group, one of the UK's most successful property and transport groups and owner of Liverpool John Lennon Airport, Mersey Docks and Manchester's Trafford Centre. The company's plans also include investment in a new superport, which will create a global trade gateway.

Detailed planning of the 18 million sq ft mixed-use scheme has begun, which will feature iconic landmark buildings along the Birkenhead and Wallasey dockside opposite Liverpool's historic waterfront. 
